- The Integrated Crop Management Practice has been eliminated from the State Cost Share Program list of practices.
- Vegetative Filter Strips are available only as a component of a related practice.
- Forest Land and Erosion Control System Forest Stewardship Incentive Plan is now funded by State Cost Share Program
- Pasture and hayland erosion control is geared toward seeding existing pastures to make them more suitable for livestock. Landowners who are still under a pasture renovation practice lifespan are not eligible for the pasture restoration.
