

## Wyoming Schuetzen Union .22 Rimfire Winter League

Interested in shooting in the Wyoming Schuetzen Union .22 Rimfire Winter League?

The WSU Winter League is a 500 shot postal match shot at 50ft indoors, offhand with .22 cal rimfire rifles.

You can shoot as individual, or as a team of 3 shooters.

The league starts the 1<sup>st</sup> full week of January and runs until the last week of March, giving everyone a couple of weeks to make up missed weeks.

The rules for the match are attached.

Essentially, this is a 500-shot match, shot 50 shots at a time for 10 weeks (with make ups allowed for weeks missed). You must shoot your targets in batches of 50 shots. The point being that 50 shots puts a small premium on endurance and concentration. If you want to make up a missed week, that's fine, but you must do it in 50-shot batches.

YOU DO NOT HAVE TO BE A WSU MEMBER to compete. In order to have our scores posted in *the Black Powder Cartridge news* the BCSC must be a member of the Wyoming Schuetzen Union. To me a member the club only needs to subscribe to a 1 year subscription to *the Black Powder Cartridge news*.

For each 50-shot set of targets, you are allowed a sighter target. But once you go for score, you have to shoot the 50 without returning to a sighter.

Targets to be use are the ASSRA or WSU 6 bull, 50-ft target. Two shots per bull for record.

This is not a money match; there are no entry fees, and no prizes, just braggin' rights. We are looking to have fun and promote the shooting of traditional rifles in stand-up matches. We will be shooting in an open class. Any single-shot rifle with any sights will be allowed as defined by the WSU (attached).

I will assume the duties of the Schuetzenmeister and take care of ordering the targets and sending in the league scores.
